The Humanitarian Catastrophe in Gaza

Two years into the ongoing crisis, Gaza remains one of the most devastated places on earth. Entire neighborhoods have been leveled, hospitals destroyed, and nearly every family displaced. What was once a vibrant community of **over two million people** has been reduced to a humanitarian emergency of unprecedented scale.

Around **2.0-2.2 million** people displaced

Displacement

Nearly Gaza's entire population — have been displaced at least once, many multiple times. Families now live in overcrowded tents, schools, or damaged shelters with little access to clean water or sanitation.

Casualties

Verified tallies vary by source, but independent and UN-linked assessments estimate tens of thousands killed and well over 150,000 injured since October 2023. Every day, new casualties are reported.

Shortage of medicinal equipments

Health System Collapse

Hospitals and clinics are barely functional. Shortages of medicine, fuel, and surgical equipment mean preventable deaths are rising sharply.

Famine and Malnutrition

The UN and WHO warn of catastrophic food insecurity — famine conditions have been confirmed in several areas. Malnutrition, particularly among children, is widespread and worsening.

Constant **danger** to entire communities

Access to Aid

Humanitarian convoys face severe restrictions and constant danger. Entire communities have been cut off from consistent food, water, and medical supplies.

How Scholars Without Borders Has Been Helping

Despite enormous challenges, Scholars Without Borders (SWB) has continued to deliver aid and hope to families in Gaza. Your donations have made a tangible difference.

Emergency Food Relief

- **8,000 date packages** distributed during Ramadan and emergency relief phases (July 2025 campaign).
- **700 fresh vegetable baskets** provided to displaced families facing food shortages.
- **1,000 family food parcels** distributed in partnership with local teams. Together, these efforts have provided **tens of thousands of meals** to families who otherwise would have gone hungry.



Medical Support

- **Construction of a 250-bed field hospital** near Nasser Medical Complex — a critical step to expand trauma and emergency care capacity for the injured and sick.
- Ongoing **supply of emergency medicine and equipment** through local partners, helping doctors treat wounded civilians and children.

Education and Orphan Support

- **New education centre under construction** in southern Gaza, serving **~1,500 students (KG-12)** — offering displaced children a safe learning environment amid the destruction.
- **Orphan care programs** continue through local partner organizations, ensuring ongoing emotional and educational support for the most vulnerable.

Water and Basic Needs

- Distribution of **clean water, hygiene kits, and essential household supplies** to families sheltering in temporary camps.
- Continued investment in **sustainable water and sanitation projects** as conditions allow.
